Pam Kannady is the Director of Human Resources for the Kansas City Public Library District in Kansas City, Missouri. Prior to her position with the Library, she served as Human Resources Director for the City of Olathe, Kansas, Director of Employee Relations for the Kansas City, Missouri School District, Director of Personnel for the Kansas State Department of Health and Environment, and held several human resources positions in Kansas State Department of Administration. She received a master's degree in public administration from the University of Kansas.

Pam was the 2008 President of IPMA-HR. She previously served as the Central Region representative to the IPMA-HR Executive Council, Central Region President, Greater Kansas City Chapter President, and as a member of many IPMA-HR national and regional committees. Neil Reichenberg is the executive director of the International Public Management Association for Human Resources (IPMA-HR).
